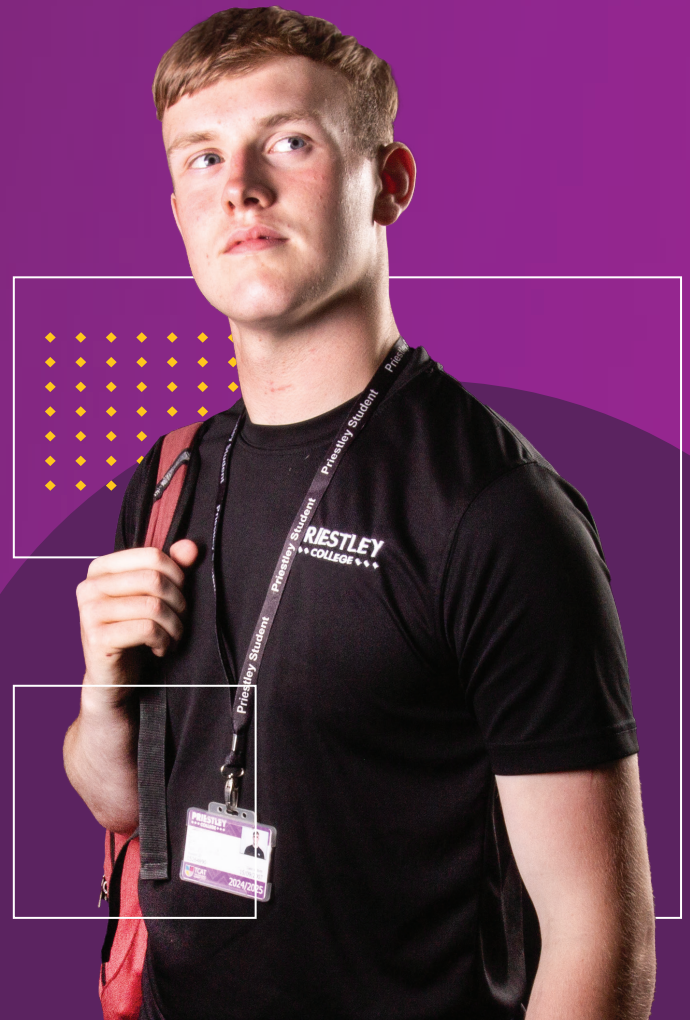

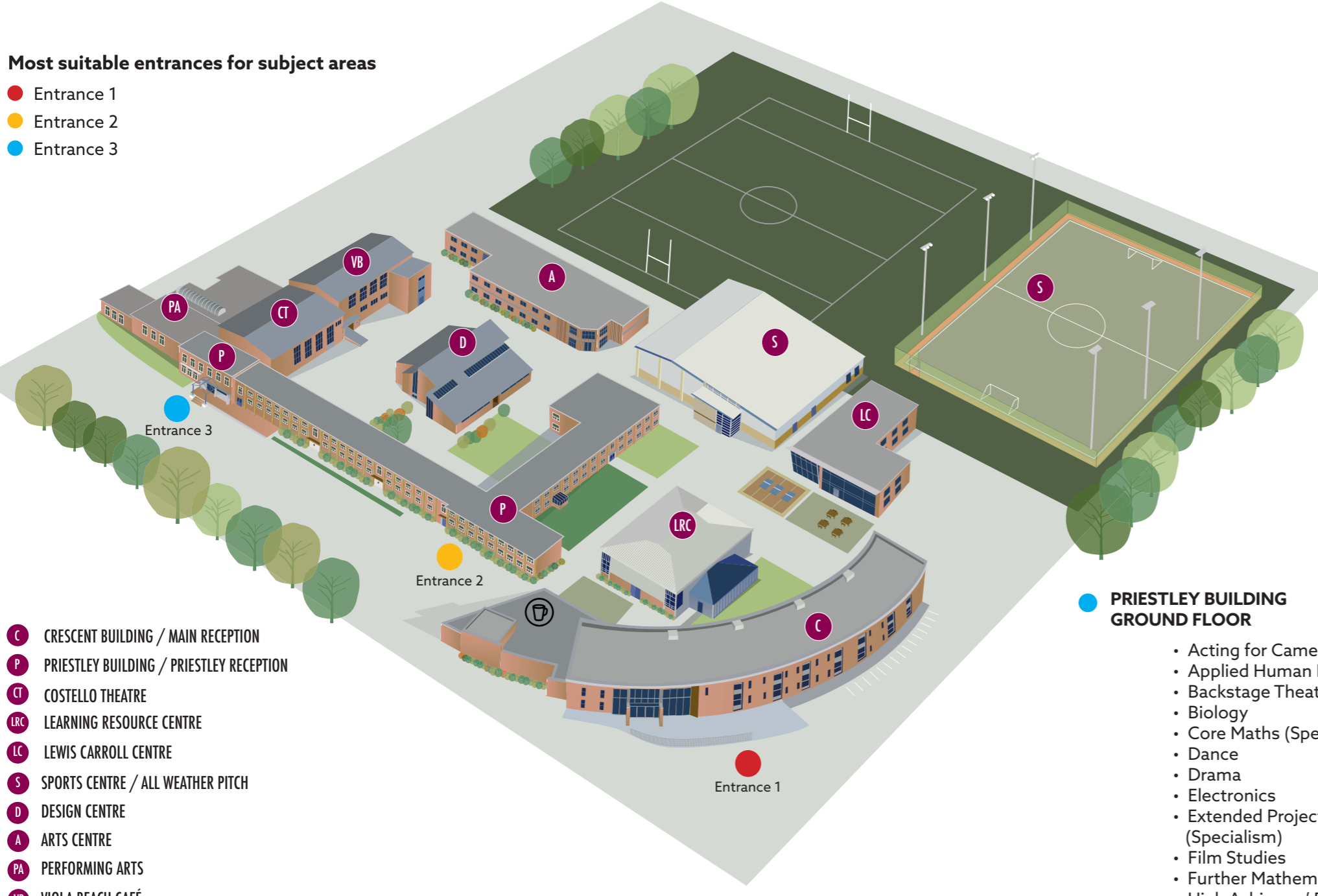
College Presentation
